

Indian Prairie District 2017 Silver Acorn Nomination

The 2017 Silver Acorns will be presented at the Indian Prairie District Recognition Dinner on Sunday, March 5, 2017.

Each unit in the district is strongly encouraged to nominate a volunteer for the Silver Acorn award. Typically, it is given to a person that has assured the unit’s success through tireless effort and commitment. The awardee does not need to be a registered leader.

The maximum number of acorns a unit may award is based on the number of youth registered to that unit on December 31, 2016: 1 to 50 - one acorn, 51 to 100 - two acorns, 101 to 150 - three acorns, etc. An acorn can be awarded to only one person and a unit may award the silver acorn to a person only once. Contact Julie Rypka, if you are unsure about how many acorns your unit may award, or if you need to know who received the award previously.

The district will not publish the list of nominees until the district dinner. The awardee and presenter from the unit will be called up by the Master of Ceremonies using a slide created by the district staff from the information provided below.
